**Schedule** 

- Entry fee (or Purchase Order/Requisition) must be submitted with application. Entry fees are non-refundable. Participation is not guaranteed until payment is received. Fee will be returned if the application is not accepted for the parade. Chamber Members will received a \$10 discount.
- Float and pulling vehicle are considered one unit.
- Units should carry through with the theme, "GPolar Gear Christmas".
- Only floats, decorated truck & trailers, decorated battery operated golf carts, convertibles and cars with sunroofs, antique tractors and antique/classic cars '69 or older will be accepted.
- All music must be related to Christmas.
- Floats need to be safe for participants as well as onlookers.
- You are asked to supply signs approximately 22"X28" to be placed on both sides of your unit for judging.
- NO ONE WILL BE ALLOWED TO THROW CANDY OR ANY ITEMS FROM FLOATS. YOU MAY HAVE SOMEONE WALK ALONGSIDE THE FLOAT AND HAND OUT TO ONLOOKERS!
- NO UNIT may include any person dressed to represent Santa Claus.
- Individual cars are allowed if it is an antique or classic car ('69 or older); or carrying an official or dignitary.
- No one will be allowed to ride on the hood, out of the window or in the bed of any vehicle.
- Small children riding should be accompanied by at least one (1) adult.
- A truck can only be used to pull a float. Some church vans may be allowed to pull floats, but no riders inside the vehicles other than driver.
- There will be **2** stopping points along the parade route. Performing Units can only stop to perform at these stops. 1st stop is at the town center by the fountain and 2nd is in front of the Old Piggly Wiggly Parking Lot.
- Performing Units will be allowed to perform for up to one (1) minute for the judges who will be located on the square.
- Parade winners will be notified Monday, December 4th.
